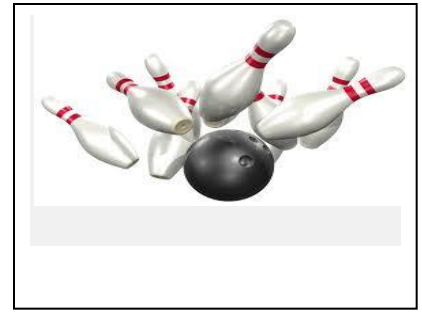




You Are Invited
