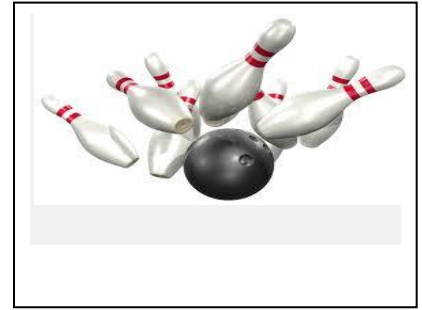




Spring Lock-In
